WARSAW FOR EVERY BUDGET

Have you ever wondered just how you can do anything interesting in Warsaw, when your pockets are almost empty? Do you know how and when to use the city's services and get access to activities? It's easy: just peruse our guide, which answers all these questions for you.

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In Poland, children and adolescents under 18 years of age are entitled to discounts, as are students, retirees, pensioners, veterans, and persons with disabilities. So before heading off anywhere, take note of the numerous discounts available.

Holders of an international Euro 26 ID card, as well as people with ISIC or IYTC cards receive a discount in hotels, restaurants, pubs, cultural centres as well as some shops and service outlets. Yet another way to save money is to buy a Warsaw Tourist Card.

What's the cheapest way to get around town? By foot, of course. But to use public transportation is not expensive, and there is a choice of bus (especially the tourist-focused 180 bus), tram and metro lines.

Discounts on tickets are offered to children, students, people over 65 years of age and pensioners.

Where to eat?

Among the many restaurants offering traditional Polish dishes and specialties from around the world, we find many which have good food and happily welcome active visitors who will linger in the establishment for many hours.

There are of course popular international fast food chains, but take note of milk bars, which are slowly disappearing into a mere culinary curiosity. Their original design - which is a relic of older times – and the cuisine will not appeal to everyone, but their uniqueness and traditional approach have won them many admirers, especially among young people. You can eat a traditional meal (soup and main dish) for 10–15 PLN. Also, in many restaurants scattered among the Old and New Towns, there are special lunch offers, allowing patrons to enjoy an early dinner for less than 20 PLN.

MUSEUMS AND GALLERIES

A visit to the museum, theatre or opera is often a big challenge for the average tourist's budget. However, many of Warsaw's museums offer weekly free tours of their exhibitions, and there are tour groups offering free walking tours daily. Also, theatres, the National Opera and Philharmonic give visitors the opportunity to see almost all of their performances and concerts for a relatively low price; in addition to the regular-priced tickets, there are cheaper tickets available.

MULTIMEDIA FOUNTAIN PARK

The Multimedia Fountain Park comprises two fountains: the main one, with area of over 2 200 sq m, and the line fountain, with the length of 120 metres, called the water organ. Free festivals and events in Warsaw (cyclical)

In Warsaw – particularly during the spring and summer months – many events take place; these events are open to the public and are free of charge. Concerts, festivals, open-air cinemas and numerous other happenings are included on the capital's annual cultural calendar, many of which attract large numbers of visitors, both from home and abroad.

Chopin Concerts

(from May to late September)

Chopin concerts are held in the Royal Łazienki Park, and they are among the most important cultural events in the country. Lovers of Fryderyk Chopin's compositions meet every Sunday afternoon in the summer at the Chopin Monument, to hear world-renowned pianists perform his best-loved works.
